Preference is given to applicants having a year of work experience related to the field of study.

* Students whose first language is not English will be required to demonstrate evidence of an adequate level of English proficiency.

Structure and Assessment

Lectures | Discussions | Online Learning | Tutorials | Case Studies

This is a part-time course which will typically take 42 months to complete. The programme consists of a total of 24 modules. The method of assessment is assignment-based.

The course comprises:

- 6 lectures per module
- 3- hour lectures (evening)
- 12 hours of online content per module, comprising asynchronous online discussions, tutorials and/or videos.

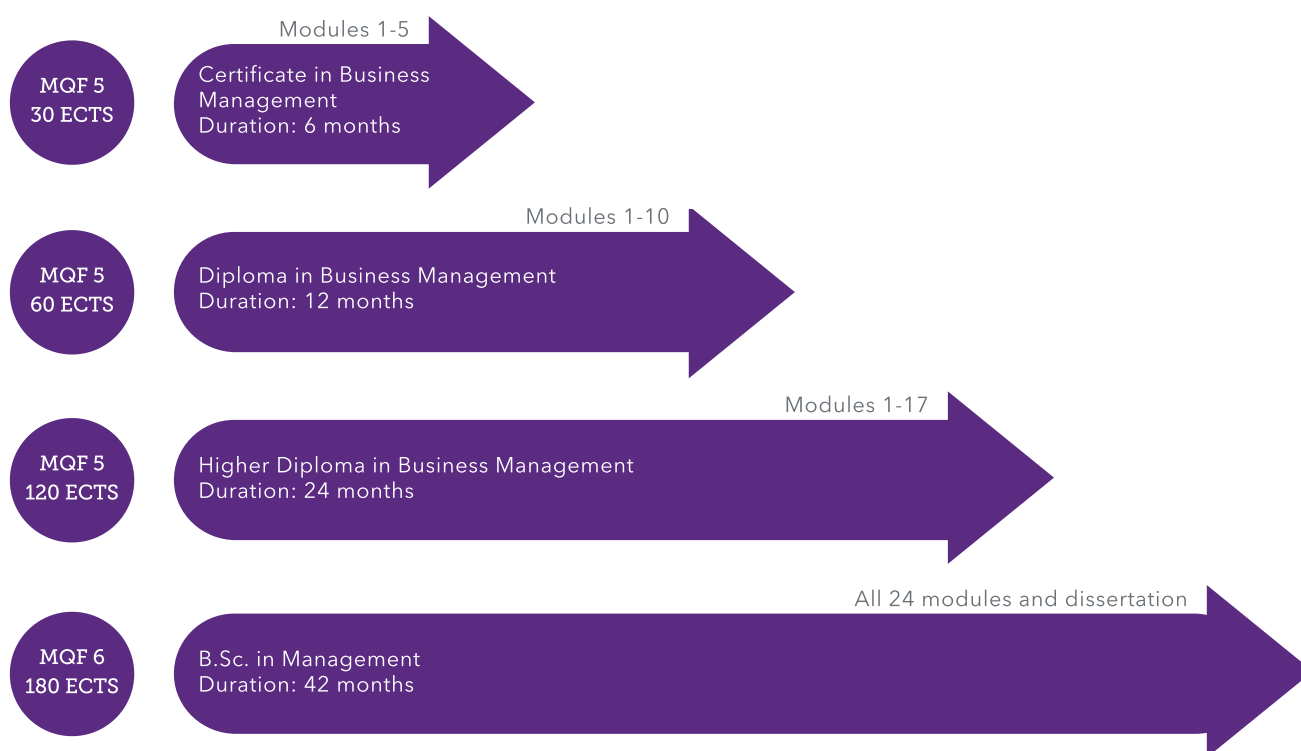
Target Audience
